“Colour copying” on a monochrome MFP with colour scanning capability

Direct forwarding of colour scans to a colour printer

Personal Copy directly forwards a document scanned on a DEVELOP B/W MFP to a colour printer. Documents are printed either immediately or after entering a 4 digits pincode at the colour printer. The output device as well as print settings like number of copies, choice of a specific paper cassette, simplex/duplex print and scan or settings for a secure print can be done at the MFP's display.

Simple handling

The user selects a colour printer directly on the MFP's display.

Requirements

Microsoft Windows XP (32-bit) or later, .NET Framework 2.0 or later. Windows Server 2003 (32-bit) or Windows Server 2008 (32-bit) is recommended, at least 512 MB RAM, OpenAPI version 2.1 or later

- DEVELOP B/W MFP with colour scanner (ineo 223, 283, 363, 423, 552, 652)

Enables colour copying on a B/W-MFP

In environments with monochrome MFPs and colour printers, Personal Copy helps optimising to print colour scans. Until now documents first had to be scanned on the monochrome MFP (having a colour scanner) and then sent to a PC via email, for example. Here the document had to be opened and print settings made on the specific printer driver before finally receiving a colour print. A lot of manual steps which now can be avoided. Personal Copy allows colour scans to be sent directly from the MFP to a colour printer. Time consuming detours via a PC are a thing of the past now.

Efficient use of the complete system fleet

Personal Copy is the ideal solution for environments where mostly monochrome printing and copying is needed and in which accordingly monochrome devices are predominant. Here Personal Copy allows efficient printing as no colour MFP has to be in use to satisfy those customer's sporadic demands for colour output. A colour printer is sufficient.
